- You have a right to be treated humanely and protected from harm.
- You have a right to meaningful and appropriate services.
- You can live and receive services in a safe, secure, and supportive environment.
- You have the right to information be confidential.
- You have the right to complain about treatment or care and to have that complaint answered promptly.
- You have the right to be informed of your rights at least annually and in a manner you can understand.
- You have the right to be free from physical punishment and painful treatment.
- You have the right to be free from abuse, neglect, exploitation or mistreatment.
- You have the right not to be placed in a room or other area from which exit is prevented.
- You have the right to be treated with dignity and respect.
- You have the right to be free from restrictions involving sleep, shelter, food, drink, medical care, use of bathroom facilities, or prolonged restriction of movement unless a doctor's order is being followed.
- You have the right to not work or perform chores without payment, except for regular chores in your home or for volunteer work that you have chosen.
- You have the right to see your doctor at your own expense regularly.
- You have the right to regular developmental and behavioral assessments.
- You have the right to refuse treatment.
- You have the right to be informed of all treatment risks.
- You have the right to be free from unnecessary physical or chemical (medication-induced) restraints.
- You have the right to personal privacy.
- You have the right to meet privately with and communicate with persons of your choosing.

- You have the right to send and receive unopened mail.
- You can make and receive telephone calls privately, at your own expense.
- You can participate in social, religious, and community activities.
- You have the right to have and use appropriate personal possessions and clothing.
- You have the right to protect personal funds and property from misuse or misappropriation.
- You have the right to have all alleged violations of your rights reported and investigated.
